- At least a bachelor's degree in English, English Literature, Journalism, Communications, or any other related field.
- A proven track record/portfolio of published research and/or editorial experience, particularly within the disciplines of Economics, Finance, and International Development.
- Demonstrated knowledge in the thematic areas relevant to CSEA's work, including economic development, policy research, and other related fields.
